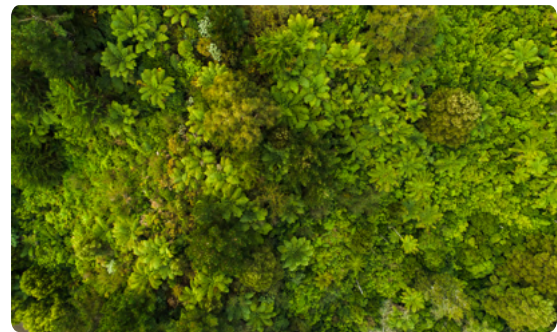

In order to provide accurate pricing and ensure compliance with waste disposal regulations, we require accurate listings of all hazardous waste items and materials. This should include the number of containers by size and accurate descriptions, MSDS (where required).

Contaminated Rags

Oil Filters

As these items contain oil, they must be treated as hazardous due to the contamination. We can collect this waste in bulk loads.



Bulk Waste In IBCs

We can also collect bulk waste contained in IBCs. This might include chemicals such as coolants, antifreeze, oil and other waste types.

Empty Contaminated Containers

We collect and dispose of contaminated waste packaging safely from businesses across the UK. These empty containers should contain less than 1% residue. Our team can collect both small and large quantities of contaminated waste, and may require an MSDS with details regarding the previous contents.



Bottles

This includes small bottles, such as those used to contain chemicals in laboratory or cleaning settings.



Small Drums

These small drums are often used for chemicals such as AdBlue, antifreeze, oil and various other chemicals.



Drums

These larger plastic or metal drums commonly have previously contained acids, solvents, oils or other hazardous substances.



Empty IBCs

Empty IBCs often contain residue from previous contents, such as fluids, liquids and various chemical types.

Chemical Waste Disposal

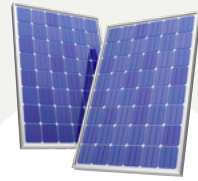
